II. Purpose of Addendum

Program director, Cody Blair submitted a modification request to add room A110 to the license and increase the center's capacity.

III. Methodology

08/17/2022: Modification request received.

08/22/2022: Inspection completed onsite.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

This license has been modified from the original terms on 03/09/2021 and 08/24/2022.

Early Impressions Little Panthers is located in Woodville Community Center in Jackson. The building is an active school as it serves high school students.

The newly approved classroom has the following measurements:

- Room A110 measures 30 ft. x 24 ft. This equals 720 square feet and can accommodate 20 children between the ages 3 – 12 years. The primary use for this classroom will serve children between the ages of 3-4 years. However, Mr. Blair has requested approval for older children as a back up space if needed. Mr. Blair understands the ratio and capacity requirements are determined by the age of the youngest child in a well-defined space. Mr. Blair also understands the need for age-appropriate equipment and play materials if older children are present in this classroom.

The following rooms continue to be approved and include:

- Room A103 measures 27 ft. x 28 ft., plus 3 ft. x 14 ft. This equals 798 sq. ft. and accommodates 22 children ages 3-5 years.
- Room A104 measures 27 ft. x 28 ft., plus 3 ft. x 14 ft. This equals 798 sq. ft. and accommodates 22 children ages 2 ½ -12 years. If children age 2 ½ to 3 years are present in this room, the maximum group size of children is 16.
- Room A105 measures 27 ft. x 30 ft. This equals 810 sq. ft and accommodates 23 children ages 2 ½ to 12 years. If children age 2 ½ to 3 years are present in this room, the maximum group size of children is 16 children.

- Room A112 measures 27 ft. x 30 ft. This equals 810 sq. ft and accommodates 23 children ages 2 ½ to 12 years. If children age 2 ½ to 3 years are present in this room, the maximum group size of children is 16 children.
- Room A114 measures 26 ft. x 22 ft., plus 8 ft. x 19 ft. This equals 724 sq. ft. and accommodates 12 children ages birth to 3 years old.
- The gymnasium measures 48 ft. x 70 ft. This equals 3360 sq. ft and accommodates 96 children ages 2 ½ and older. If children age 2 ½ to 3 years old are present in this room, the maximum group size of children is 16 children.

Program Description:

The center operates year-round, Monday through Friday, 6:00am to 6:00pm. The center offers both full time and part time care. The child care center provides two ready-to-eat snacks. The center does not provide transportation or swimming activities.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of room A110 and increasing the center capacity from 102, to 122.
