II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee is requesting to add Room 111 and Room 113 to the license. This will increase the center's capacity to 164 children ages birth to 12 years old.

III. Methodology

7/30/2020: Lead Risk Assessment that included Room 111 and Room 113.

12/1/2022: Certification of School Building Fire Safety Provisions

1/23/23: Environmental Health Inspection.

3/01/2023: On- Site Inspection

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 3/9/21, 9/22/21, and 3/1/23.

Early Impressions Little Panthers is in Woodville Community Center. The building is an active school as it serves high school students. The center operates year-round and cares for children ages birth to 12 years. Th center provides both full time and part time care. Meals are provided by an off-site licensed kitchen. The center does not provide transportation. The center does not participate in swimming.

The center is adding Room 111 and Room 113 to the license.

The center is now approved for the following rooms:

Room 103 measures 27 ft. x31 ft., minus 3 ft. x12.5 ft. This totals 799.5 sq. ft. and accommodates 22 children 2 ½ and older. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Room 104 measures 27 ft. x31 ft., minus 3 ft. x12.5 ft. This totals 799.5 sq. ft. and accommodates 22 children 2 ½ and older. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Room 105 measures 27 ft x 31 ft. This totals 837 sq. ft. and accommodates 24 children ages 2 ½ and older. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Room 110 measures 28ft. x 30ft. This totals 840 sq. ft. and accommodates 24 children ages 2 ½ and older. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Add Room 111 measures 28ft. x 30ft. This totals 840 sq. ft. and accommodates 24 children ages 2 ½ and older. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Room 112 measures 28ft. x 30ft. This totals 840 sq. ft. and accommodates 24 children ages 2 ½ and older. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Add Room 113 measures 28ft. x 30ft. This totals 840 sq. ft. and accommodates 12 children ages birth to 3 years old.

Add Room 114 measures 28ft. x 30ft. This totals 840 sq. ft. and accommodates 12 children ages birth to 3 years old.

The gymnasium is used as additional child use space. The gymnasium measures 48 ft. x 70 ft. This equals 3360 sq. ft and accommodates 96 children ages 2 ½ years and older. If children 2 ½ -3 years old are present, the maximum group size is 16 children. If the youngest child is 3 years old, the maximum group size is 30 children. If the youngest child is 4 years old or older, the maximum groups size is 36 children.

Total Capacity: 164 children.

The children may spread out in the center, as longer as there is never more than 164 children at one time, and the individual rooms capacities, approved age ranges, and groups sizes are not exceeded.

The center has enough sinks and toilets to support a capacity of 164 children. The center has a variety of play and learning equipment. The equipment supports a capacity of 164 children.

An Environmental Health Inspection with an "A" rating was completed on 1/23/23. A superintendent signed school fire compliance was received on 12/1/22. A passing lead risk assessment was completed on 7/30/20.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of Room 111 and Room 113. I recommend an increase in the license capacity to 164 children.
