II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee is requesting to add Rooms 206 and 207. The licensee is requesting to change the approved age ranges to now include children ages 2 ½ - 12 years to support the center's preschool, GSRP, and school age programming. The licensee is requesting increase the center's capacity to 65 children.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Early Impressions Springport is located inside Springport Elementary School. The school is an active school building serving grades kindergarten through 5th grade. The center will now provide GSRP, preschool, and school age care.

The approved use space now includes:

Room 204 measures 32.5 ft. x 23.5 ft., plus 5.5 ft. x 7.5 ft. This equals 805 sq. ft. and accommodates 23 children ages 2 ½ - 12 years old. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present in the room, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Room 206 measures 32.5 ft. x 23 ft., plus 6 ft x 6 ft. This equals 783.5 sq. ft. and accommodates 22 children aged 2 ½ - 12 years old. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present in the room, the maximum group size is 16 children.

Room 207 measures 22 ft. x 31 ft., plus 6 ft. x 6 ft. This equals 718 sq. ft. and accommodates 20 children aged 2 ½ - 12 years old. If children aged 2 ½ to 3 years old are present in the room, the maximum groups size is 16 children.

Total capacity: 65 children ages 2 ½ to 12 years.

The children may be spread out throughout the center, as long as there are never more than 65 children present, and the individual room capacities and group size requirements remain in compliance.

The center has six sinks and six toilets available for the children's use. This is more than adequate for the capacity. The center has an adequate amount of play and learning equipment.

A signed superintendent statement regarding school fire safety provisions was signed on 5/19/2021. A new environmental health inspection is not required at this time. This area of the building was new constructions in 1995. As such, a lead risk assessment is not required.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the approved use rooms now include Room 204, 206, and 207. I recommend that the age ranges now include children ages 2 ½ - 12 years to support the center's preschool, GSRP, and school age programming. I recommend an increase in the center's capacity to 65 children.
