III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

Early Impressions Springport is located inside Springport Elementary School. The school is an active school building serving grades kindergarten through 5th grade.

The center operates as a Great Start to Readiness Program and uses Room 204 for child care. Room 204 measures 32.5 ft. x 23.5 ft., plus 5.5 ft. x 7.5 ft. This equals 805 sq. ft and accommodates the requested total capacity of 16 children ages 3 – 5 years old.

Total Capacity: 16 children ages 3-5 years old.

Equipment:

The center has an adequate supply of play and learning equipment. The equipment is adequate for both the ages of the children served and the center's capacity. The room arrangement is conducive to a preschool setting.

Number of sinks and toilets:

The center has access to two sinks and two toilets in the room.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards:

The outdoor play area is partially fenced and located at the side of the school. There are no nearby water hazards.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results:

The center is not required to complete a lead risk assessment. The area of the building that is utilized by the center was newly constructed in 1995.

Documentation of playground safety:

The outdoor play area does not contain any large outdoor climbers that would require a playground inspection at this time.

B. Program Description

Ages of children served:

The center will accept children ages 3 to 5 years of age.

Proposed days and hours of operation:

The GSRP program operates during the school year Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 7:30 – 2:30pm.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both):

The center offers full time programming.

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service:

The center does not provide transportation or swimming. The center will provide meals and snacks prepared by the school's licensed kitchen.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified:

The approved program director is Kathleen Caldwell under Rule R400.8113(7)(a) and (9). She has completed Bachelor of Science degree in Early Childhood Education from Baker College. She has completed at least 2 semester hours in Child Care Administration coursework.

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement? A central administration is not required as Ms. Caldwell has completed the required semester hours in child care administration.


Explanation of variance(s), if any: There are no rule variances.
