III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

Early Impressions Parma is located in the community room at Parma Village Hope Church. The following room is approved for child care use:

The GSRP Classroom measures 27 feet x 24 feet providing 648 total square feet. This is enough space for 18 children ages 3 to 5 years.

Equipment:

There is a wide variety and adequate amount of age appropriate equipment available for children's use. The quantity of equipment supports the center's capacity.

Number of sinks and toilets:

There is a total of 3 toilets, 1 urinal and 4 sinks available for children's use. This is enough to accommodate the center's capacity.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards:

The outdoor play area is located on the side of the building. The outdoor play area is completely fenced by a four-foot chain link fence. There is no installed playground equipment. The center will utilize portable toys for outdoor play such as chalk, bubbles, a plastic bowling game, a portable basketball hoop and parachutes. There are trees around the outdoor play area to provide adequate shade. There are no water hazards located on or around the outdoor play area.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results:

A lead hazard risk assessment is not required for this child care center. The community center where the classroom is located was built after 1978.

Documentation of playground safety:

There is no installed playground equipment. Therefore, a playground safety inspection is not required.

B. Program Description

Ages of children served:

The center will care for children ages 3 to 5 years.

Proposed days and hours of operation:

The center will operate during the school year, Monday through Friday, 8:30am 3:30pm.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both):

The center will offer full time care.

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service:

Meals will be provided by Wester School District. The center does not provide transportation or swimming activities.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified:

Colleen Smith is the is the approved program director. Ms. Smith qualifies under R400.8113 (7)(a) and (9).

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement?

Ms. Smith is the approved central administrator.

Explanation of variance(s), if any:

There were no variances granted.

C. Rule/Statutory Violations

There were no rule violations.
