

The following room is approved for child care use: The GSRP Classroom measures 27 feet x 24 feet providing 648 total square feet. This is enough space for 18 children ages 3 to 5 years. There is a wide variety and adequate amount of age appropriate equipment available for children's use. The outdoor play area is located on the side of the building. The outdoor play area is completely fenced. There is no installed playground equipment.
