The licensee has requested the use of a new child use space for child care children.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 09/24/2007, 10/08/2008, 10/02/2009, 10/21/2010 and 10/8/2014 and 08/02/2023.

The child care will add
Room 132 measures 24 ft x 34 ft for a total of 816 square feet. This allows for a capacity of 23 children aged 4-12 years old.

Additional approved classrooms include:

There are a total of 11 toilets, 3 urinals and 11 hand washing sinks for child use. There are plenty of toilets and had washing sinks to accommodate 50 children.

Tobey Elementary was built in 1954. A lead risk assessment was completed by Doug Haase of Analytical Testing and Consulting Services, Inc. on 9/2/2014. Another assessment was completed on 08/25/2022 by Chantelle Lynch of Analytical Testing and Consulting Services, Inc. The lead dust wipe results indicated that all samples in room 103 and 132 tested below regulatory standards, therefore is not considered lead hazardous.

The school is part of the city sewage system, therefore a new inspection by the Environmental Health Department is not required at this time.

Tobey Elementary School is considered a school building, therefore, is exempt from fire safety rules. The Fire Marshal inspection report was completed on 2/5/2009.

The unfenced outdoor play area is located behind the school. The playground used by children who attend Kids Klub has not been inspected; therefore it may not comply with current playground safety regulations. Preschool children will not be

using this play structure. There are no water hazards on the property.

This all day preschool program is open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:40 p.m. during the school year only. Children between the ages of 4 and 5 can attend this preschool program. Breakfast, lunch, snacks and transportation will be provided to the children.

The Kids Klub before and after school program is open Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. during the school year only. Children between the ages of 5 and 12 can attend this child care program. Breakfast and snacks are provided to the children. Parents are responsible for transporting children to and from this child care program.

There are an adequate number and varied amount of toys and other learning equipment to accommodate both the ages and capacity of children served at this child care center.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the additional use of room 132 to child use space.
