Dear Ms. Jackson-Spaner:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 03/20/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the on-site inspection, I observed two GSRP classrooms. Room 104 had three child care staff members, one volunteer, and ten preschool-aged children in the room. I observed handwashing and breakfast time. The children were served cheerios and 1% single-serve containers of milk. After breakfast, the children broke out into groups for fine motor activities in different areas of the classroom.

Room 105 had two child care staff members and eleven preschool-age children in the room. I observed music and movement time and circle time where the children were graphing, counting, and writing their numbers. I accompanied them to "picture day" which took place in the media center which is approved child use space. Child care staff members provided direct supervision while in the media center and then they returned to their classroom and the children engaged in fine motor activities where choices were given in what they wanted to do.

No hazards were identified in either classroom and the program was always within their capacity and ratios. I reviewed some child and staff records, and all were in compliance. Technical assistance was provided for some name tags and shapes that were taped to the floor and carpeting but starting to peel. I explained that once they start to come up, they need to be replaced because then they cannot be easily cleaned and sanitized.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.
