III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, I observed child care children engaged in various developmental and age-appropriate activities, including singing songs with the child care staff, reading books, playing with Legos, dolls, and playing outside on the playground. The child care staff did a great job intervening with children when needed, redirecting them, and talking to them about their feelings and behaviors. I

also observed lunch and diapering and all child care licensing rules were followed. The child care staff interacted with the children by talking with them while diapering and during lunchtime while they ate together.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
