R 400.8143(1)	<p>At the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. The center shall keep it on file and accessible in the center.</p>
R 400.8152(8)	<p>Topical nonprescription medication, including but not limited to diapering cream, triple antibiotic, sunscreen, and insect repellent, requires written parental authorization annually.</p>
R 400.8143(12)	<p>A parent's written permission for the child's participation in field trips must be obtained at the time of enrollment or before each field trip, and kept on file at the center.</p>
R 400.8176(11)	<p>A crib or porta-crib must have a firm, tight-fitting waterproof mattress.</p>
R 400.8545(3)	<p>Fire extinguishers shall be properly mounted, inspected, and maintained in accordance with NFPA(10). The fire extinguisher shall bear a tag indicating the last date of inspection or service and the initials of the person who performed the inspection or service.</p>
