Approved Child Use Space: The center is located within Schoolcraft Elementary School building. The approved child use space includes five classrooms (room 401, 402, 101-Discovery, 103-music, 105-game), the gym, library, cafeteria, cafeteria stage, and the book-nook for pick up/drop off of The Eagle Zone program. The Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) is located primarily in rooms 401 and 402.

**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, I observed child care children involved in various developmentally appropriate activities throughout the day, including free choice time, journaling/iPad time, learning about numbers and shapes, and playing duck duck

goose. Child care staff were sitting with the children and interacting with them in a caring and nurturing manner.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:	
<b>R 400.8128</b>	<b>Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.</b>
	<b>A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.</b>
Four child care staff did not have a TB test and results on file.	
<b>R 400.8131</b>	<b>Professional development requirements.</b>
	<b>(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.</b>
Five child care staff have not completed one or more of the required 2020-2022 health and safety refresher trainings.

	<b>(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.</b>
Four child care staff did not have prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect training completed.

Four child care staff did not have prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations completed.

One child care staff was missing verification of 16 hours of annual professional development for 2021 and 2022.	
<b>R 400.8146</b>	<b>Information provided to parents.</b>
	<b>(2) Written documentation that the parent received the written information packet, as required by subrule (1) of this rule, must be kept on file at the center.</b>
Ten children's records were reviewed. Eight children did not have documentation signed by the parent that they had received the parent handbook.	
<b>R 400.8161</b>	<b>Emergency procedures.</b>
	<b>(7) A written log indicating the date and time of fire and tornado drills must be kept on file at the center.</b>

The center was missing verification of a fire drill completed in the September thru November 2022 quarter. The center was missing verification of a second tornado drill completed between March and November 2022.	
<b>R 400.8340</b>	<b>Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.</b>
	<b>(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.</b>
Parents provide lunch for some of the child care children. Not all lunch bags are being labeled with the child's first and last name and date.	

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/13/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
