8131(10)	Two staff who work directly with children did not have CPR or FA within 90 days of hire.	We are all due for a CPR/FA renewal. Will get a group training over the summer.	9/30/22
8146(2)	Five child files reviewed did not have written documentation that the parent received the written information packet.	The five receipt of parent handbook forms were signed and are now in child files.	6/6/22
8152(8)	Six child files reviewed did not have topical prescription permission forms updated annually.	Laura will ask parents to initial the sunscreen forms each year and add a grid at bottom to make sure it is easier to track.	6/30/2022
8315(6)	In the preschool kitchen, windex and bleach were stored in a cabinet with plates, bowls, cups and utensils.	Lead teachers have removed chemicals from cupboards where dishes are stored.	6/6/22

8340(3)	Eleven lunches in the preschool and toddler rooms did not have the child's first and last names and in both refrigerators, children's food was uncovered. For example, there was a half-eaten banana that was left in the fridge in the peel, and an uncovered macaroni and cheese.	Laura has communicated with teachers and will be checking on continuous compliance	6/6/22
8545(3)	A fire extinguisher in the farmhouse entry area was not properly mounted and all fire extinguishers had not been inspected monthly and initialed.	Leslie has talked with Ty and put a ticket in to ensure the fire extinguisher will be mounted properly and inspected.	9/30/22
8152(6)	Four infants had been administered Tylenol which states under 2 years should have a doctors instruction for dosage. There was not a dr. note on file.	Leslie will inform all parents and work with lead teachers to ensure that no child under 2 is given Tylenol without a dr. note.	

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
