II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee requested to add Room 203 to the approved child use space and to increase capacity from 48 to 58.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility is located within the Second Reformed Church and the rooms approved for child use space rooms 204, 205, 207, and 210-212. The facility has requested to add room 203 for child use space.

Room 203 measures approximately 18ft. x 19ft.; providing a total of 342 square feet. This accommodates a capacity of 10 children ages 2.5 to 12 years of age.

Room 204 measures approximately 37ft. x 23ft.; providing a total of 851 square feet. This accommodates a capacity of 24 children ages 3 to 12 years of age.

Room 205 measures approximately 20ft. x 13ft.; providing a total of 260 square feet. This accommodates a capacity of 5 children. The licensee has requested a capacity of 4 children ages 18 months to 3 years of age.

Room 207 measures approximately 19ft. x 15ft.; providing a total of 285 square feet. This accommodates a capacity of 8 children ages 2 ½ to 12 years of age.

Rooms 210-212 is one large room that is separated into three defined spaces and measures approximately 19ft. x 17ft., 15ft. x 13 ft., and 15ft. x 13ft.; providing a total of 713 square feet. This accommodates a capacity of 14 children. The licensee has requested a capacity of 12 children ages infant to 18 months based on group size.

Equipment: The facility has the required amount of developmentally appropriate equipment for the ages and capacity requested.

Number of sinks and toilets: The facility has access to a total of 5 toilets and 6 handwashing sinks.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results:
A lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 05/07/2021 and found no hazards present.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of room 203 and the increase in capacity from 48 to 58 children.
