On 9/08/2022, Program Director Michelle View submitted a modification request to add serving school aged children as a program component.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 3/29/2011, 8/16/2016, 8/17/2020, 8/18/2021, and 10/20/2022.

On 10/10/2022, an on-site inspection was made to the licensed facility in order to inspect the school age equipment and use space.

The center keeps a wheeled cart in a storage room in the gym with school aged activities and equipment. They also have an adequate amount of gross motor toys and games that the children can utilize. There are tables and chairs available to the school aged children that are sized appropriately for children of that age range. The center plans on only using space that has been previously approved by licensing to care for school aged children.

The center plans on having school aged children in their program only on snow days or during the school's professional development days and does not plan on serving school aged children on a daily basis. The Center's program director, Michelle View will be available to the center staff and children during these times.

A new Lead Hazard assessment, Environmental Health and Fire Safety Inspections were not required for this modification.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of adding school aged children to the center's program components.
