III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS



Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I observed large and small group activities, free play, arts and crafts activities, academic activities, snack service, field trip activities, children's departure, and positive interactions between staff and child care children. Technical assistance and consultation was provided regarding emergency plans for children with medical needs and allergies.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.
