II. Purpose of Addendum

On 11/27/2019 Wee Knights child care center submitted a modification request asking to change the ages of classroom 108 from 18 months to 2 years to 12 months to 2 years of age.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on July 27, 2006, November 10, 2008, July 21, 2015, October 21, 2019 and December 04, 2019. On 10/09/2019 I inspected classroom 108 which measured 18 ft. x 29 ft. providing a total of 522 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 10 children aged 12 months to 2 years of age.

The center currently has the following classrooms approved:

- Room 105 is 36 ft. x 28 ft., providing a total of 1008 square feet, minus 23 ft. x 138 ft., for a desk area, for a total of 870 usage square feet. This accommodates the capacity for 25 children aged 2 ½ years old and older. This room is used to provide care for children during the summer months.
- Room 109 is 982 square feet, which accommodates the capacity of 19 infants from birth to 2 years of age. This classroom is divided into two defined use areas.
- Room 110 is 924 square feet which accommodates the capacity of 18 children aged 18 months through 3 years of age. There is one sink and one toilet in this classroom.
- Room 111 is 1140 square feet, which accommodates the capacity of 33 preschoolers aged 3 years and older.
- Room 102 is used for school aged children aged five years and older in the before and after school program. The total space is sufficient for a total center capacity of 114 children, infant through school aged.

There are a total of 13 hand washing sinks, 14 toilets and 4 urinals located throughout the center. This supports the center's capacity. The classrooms are

furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. There is an adequate amount of equipment to support the capacity increase. An environmental health inspection was completed on 10/21/2019 in which the center received an A rating. The center is located inside a school building and is not required to complete a fire safety inspection. A lead assessment was not required as the building was built after 1978.

Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 114 children age birth to 17 years. The center operates Monday through Friday from 6:00am to 6:00pm and offers before and after school care for school aged children.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approving room 108 for children aged 12 months to 2 years of age.
