II. Purpose of Addendum

On October 19, 2022, I received a Request for Modification form (CCL-5054) from licensee designee, Lori Bramble-Romeo requesting approval of the Healthy Living Classroom (Room 125). This room has not been measured in the past, so the capacity of the space is unknown.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 03/07/2018 and 10/26/2022.

The child care center is located in Crestwood Middle School in the Kentwood Public School District. This center offers after-school programming operated through the school district.

The entire school building is approved for child use.

The areas the program uses on a regular basis are:

- Gymnasium is 90 ft. X 97 ft. providing a total of 8,730 square feet. This accommodates 249 school aged children.
- Collaboration Center (505) is approximately 56 ft. X 40 ft. (the stage was not measured) providing a total of 2,240 square feet. This accommodates 64 school aged children.
- Café is an irregularly shaped room and is approximately 41 ft. X 60 ft. providing a total of 2,460 square feet. This accommodates 70 school aged children.
- Media Center is an irregularly shaped room and is approximately 54 ft. X 47 ft. providing a total of 2,538 square feet. This accommodates 73 school aged children.
- Computer Lab (101) is 26 ft. X 26 ft. providing a total of 676 square feet. This accommodates 19 school aged children.
- ARCH room (100) is 26 ft. X 24 ft. providing a total of 624 square feet. This accommodates 18 school aged children.

Classrooms used by the after-school program will vary year to year. Most of the classrooms are similar in size and shape. Below is a sampling of a few classrooms and their capacity.

- Classroom 202 is 21 ft. X 30 ft. providing a total of 630 square feet. This accommodates 18 school aged children.

- Classroom 303 is 20 ft. X 28 ft. providing a total of 560 square feet. This accommodates 16 school aged children.
- Classroom 501 is 24 ft. X 29 ft. providing a total of 696 square feet. This accommodates 20 school aged children.
- The Healthy Living classroom (Room 125) has two sides:
 - The kitchen side is 27 ft. X 24 ft. providing a total of 648 square feet. This will accommodate 18 school aged children.
 - The classroom side is 21 ft. X 27 ft. providing a total of 567 square feet. This will accommodate 16 school aged children.

The total space is sufficient for a total capacity of 90 school aged children.

There are sufficient toilets and sinks to accommodate this capacity.

A fire marshal approval was completed at the time of original license issuance. An environmental health inspection was completed on 03/01/2018.

Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 90 school aged children.

The center offers after-school programming during the school year and summer school session. Meals are prepared on-site through the Kentwood Public Schools Food Service Department. The after-school program offers dinner and a snack during the school year. Lunch and a snack are provided during the summer session.

Transportation is offered for both the school year and summer after-school programming by the school district.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the Healthy Living Classroom (Room 125) as approved child use space.
