Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I observed dinner preparation, dinner, homework time, activity time, snack, and dismissal. Child care staff members provided appropriate care and supervision during activities and transitions. Staff interacted with children in a positive and friendly manner. They used

reminders and redirection as positive discipline strategies. Center, staff, and child records were made readily available.

As a result of the renewal inspection on 2/13/2024, licensing consultant Jessica Miranda-Bevier did not find any rule or law violations. A regular license will be issued.

R 400.8325(1)	All tableware, utensils, food contact surfaces, and food service equipment must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each use. Multipurpose tables must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized before and after they are used for meals or snacks.
