During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8134

Hand washing.

(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:

(a) Before meals, snacks, or food preparation experiences.

Child care children did not wash their hands prior to receiving their snack.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

After receipt of an approved corrective action plan, I recommend no change to the status of the child care license.
