III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I observed infant feeding and sleeping, lunch service, outdoor play, literacy activities, transition from one activity to the next, free play, snack service, children’s arrival and departure, arts and crafts activities, rest time, and positive and nurturing interactions between staff and child care children.

Technical assistance and consultation was provided regarding the labeling all water bottles, children's records and obtaining annual SOS records on the center's bus drivers.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
