III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I observed arts and crafts activities, free play, literacy activities, small and large group activities, outdoor play, gross motor activity, dramatic play, lunch service, snack service, transition from one activity to the next, rest time, and positive and nurturing interactions between staff and child care children. Technical assistance and consultation was provided regarding the health

and safety trainings, required postings, infant bottle labeling, and required paperwork for the center's buses.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
