This letter is a follow-up to the incident report received on 11/7/2023. The incident report completed by Emily Dunn indicated that on 11/7/2023, Child A (male, age 23 months), who has a known milk allergy, consumed milk from a cup intended for another child. Child A had an allergic reaction. Child A started to vomit and had swelling of the ears. An epi-pen was administered by staff on-site, and 911 was called. EMS arrived and reported Child A's vitals were good. Child A's Mother reported Child A was monitored at home and had no other adverse reactions. Emily Dunn advised that, moving forward, each classroom will have a staff member sitting at the table before any food or drink is served. Classrooms with milk allergies will also use cups with lids, and the center directors will check in with classrooms to ensure new protocols are followed.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8125(1) Staff; volunteer; requirements.

All staff and volunteers shall provide appropriate care and supervision of children at all times.

Child care staff members did not provide appropriate care and supervision when allowing Child A to access a known allergen.

Due to the violations identified, a written corrective action plan is required. The corrective action plan is due 15 days from the date of this letter and must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.

- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

The Department provides technical assistance to meet the licensing requirements and consultation to improve services.


