II. Purpose of Addendum

On October 19, 2022, I received a Request for Modification form (CCL-5054) from licensee designee Lori Bramble-Romeo requesting approval of Room 329 as child use space. This room has not been measured in the past, so the capacity of the space is unknown.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 12/01/2017. The child care center is located in Pinewood Middle School in the Kentwood Public School district. This center offers after-school programming operated through the school district.

The entire school building is approved as child use space.

The areas the program uses on a regular basis are:

- Gymnasium is approximately 92 ft. x 99 ft. which is 9,108 square feet. This will accommodate 260 school age children.
- Cafeteria is approximately 68 ft. x 90 ft. which is 6,120 square feet. This will accommodate 175 school age children.
- Media center/library is approximately 30 ft. x 60 ft. which is 1,800 square feet. This will accommodate 51 school age children.
- ARCH Room (110) is irregularly shaped and is approximately 24 ft. X 14 ft. and 26 ft. X 12 ft. which is 648 square feet. This will accommodate 19 school age children.
- Room 6A is approximately 33 ft. x 27 ft. which is 891 square feet. This will accommodate 25 school age children.
- Room 6B measures approximately 33 ft. x 27 ft. which is 891 square feet. This will accommodate 25 school age children.
- Computer Lab B is approximately 30 ft. x 26 ft. which is 780 square feet. This will accommodate 22 school age children.
- Room 329 measures 27 ft. by 23 ft. which is 627 square feet. This will accommodate 18 school aged children.

Classrooms used may change from year to year. Most classrooms are similar in size and shape. Below is a sample of three typically sized classrooms:

- Room 8B is approximately 33 ft. x 27 ft. which is 891 square feet. This will accommodate 25 school age children.

- Room 706 measures approximately 25 ft. x 25ft. which is 625 square feet. This will accommodate 18 school age children.
- Room 809 measures approximately 25 ft. x 25 ft. which is 625 square feet. This will accommodate 18 school age children.

There are a total of 13 sinks and 15 toilets located throughout the center. This supports the center's capacity.

An "A" rated environmental health inspection was completed on 11/30/2017. A fire marshal approval was completed on 08/06/2009.

Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 100 children ages 11 to 12 years.

The program offers meals and snacks that are prepared on-site by the Kentwood Public School Food Service Department. Dinner and a snack are offered during the school year. Lunch and a snack are offered during the summer programming.

Transportation is provided for the after-school program by the school district.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of Room 329 as child use space.
