II. Purpose of Addendum

On November 1, 2021, I received a Request for Modification form (CCL-5054) from program director, Kassandra Gutierrez requesting approval of the newly installed playground equipment.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of this license have been modified on 03/15/2017, 08/24/2018, 09/02/2020, 03/22/2021, 08/25/2021, and 11/01/2021

Living Stones Academy Preschool is housed in the Living Stones Academy school building which includes grades Preschool through Sixth.

The following rooms are approved for child use space:

- Preschool (room 105) is an irregularly shaped room measuring 31 ft. X 27 ft. and 7 ft. X 10 ft. and 3.5 ft X 6 ft. providing a total of 928 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 12 preschool aged children.
- Preschool (room 107) is 35 ft X 29 ft. providing a total of 1,015 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 24 preschool aged children.

The following rooms are also approved but not included in the total center capacity:

- Library (room 103) is an irregularly shaped room measuring approximately 39 ft. X 23 ft. and 4.5 ft. X 14 ft. providing a total of 960 square feet. This accommodates 27 preschool aged children.
- Music Room (room 112) is approximately 29 ft. X 28 ft. providing a total of 812 square feet. This accommodates 23 preschool aged children.
- Gymnasium is approximately 56 ft. X 36 ft. providing a total of 2,184 square feet.

This accommodates 62 preschool aged children. The total space is sufficient for a total capacity of 24 preschool aged children.

There are seven sinks and 13 toilets and four urinals accessible to preschool children. This supports the increase in the center's capacity. The rooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment.

An "A" rated environmental health inspection was completed on 07/31/2014. A Certification of School Building Fire Safety Provisions (BCAL-5043) was signed by the head of school on 01/21/2021. A Lead Hazard Risk Assessment was completed on 09/16/2014. The assessment documents that there were no lead hazards present in the facility. The kitchen is licensed through the Kent County Health Department and has a current food service license. A playground inspection was completed on 10/12/2021 by an approved playground inspector. The playground equipment is approved for children between the ages of 2-5 years old.

Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 36 children aged three to five.

The center offers both full-time and part-time programming during the school year. Snacks and lunches are provided by parents of enrolled children. Children do have the option to order lunches from the school. The kitchen is licensed and food is prepared on-site.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the new playground.
