III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8173 Equipment.

- (4) Play equipment, materials, and furniture, must be all of the following:
 - (d) Easily accessible to the children.

The toys in the Lyric and Pedal classrooms were very minimal. While in the Lyric classroom I asked staff members where many of the toys were for certain centers. Staff stated they had put them up because children were putting them in their mouths and throwing them. They stated they would put them back out later in the day.

R 400.8340 Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.

- (3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.

The infant classroom had three bottles not labeled with a child's name and three other bottles not labeled with the date. The Faris classroom had three bottles and three infant food containers not labeled with the date.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

- (5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.

There was chipping paint and exposed drywall in the Pedal, Otis, and GSRP classrooms.

I provided technical assistance about ensuring diaper creams and water bottle are labeled with the child's first and last names.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care center.
