## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

\*During the onsite inspection, I was able to observe the AM class participate in small group activities, large group activities, and dismissal

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8128                      Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.**

**A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours perweek for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.**

At the time of the onsite inspection, two caregivers were missing this documentation. Per Ms. Snyder, both caregivers have had TB tests with negative results and she will make sure that this documentation is on file at the center.

**R 400.8143                      Children's records.**

**(6) Within 30 days of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain, keep on file, and make accessible in the center a record of a physical evaluation of the child that notes any restrictions and is signed by a physician or the physician's designee. An electronic record from a physician's office will be accepted. The physical evaluation must be performed within 1 of the following time limits:**


- (a) For an infant, within the preceding 3 months.**
- (b) For toddlers, within the preceding 6 months.**
- (c) For preschoolers, within the preceding 12 months.**

At the time of the onsite inspection, 3 of 10 children's records reviewed did not have a physical evaluation signed by a physician. This appears to have been an oversight as the physical forms were in the children's files, having been filled out and returned without a physician signature.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 04/12/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
