

These semester hours or CEUs may satisfy a portion of the requirements of subrule (6) of this rule.	At the time of the onsite inspection, the toddler room lead caregiver did not have at least 3 sem. hours and/or 4.5 ceus in infant/toddler development and care.	Violation Established

R 400.8325(1)	All tableware, utensils, food contact surfaces, and food service equipment must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each use. Multipurpose tables must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized before and after they are used for meals or snacks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I provided information regarding getting the correct bleach concentration of 50 ppm to 200ppm for the sanitizing step.
