Approved Child Use Space:

The center is located inside the Bethany Assembly of God. The center provides infant, toddler, preschool, and school age programming. The center participates in food service, swimming, and transportation. The approved rooms are as follows:

- The Infant Room accommodates up to 8 infants ages birth – 2 years.
- The Walker Room accommodates up to 6 children ages birth – 2 years.
- The Toddler Room accommodates up to 12 children 1 ½ - 3 years.
- Preschool Room 1 accommodates up to 16 children ages 2 ½ - 3 years.
- Preschool Room 2 accommodates up to 20 children ages 3-4 years.
- The Pre K Room (School-age Room) accommodates up to 140 children ages 5-12 years.

The approved capacity is 150 children at any one time in the facility ages birth - 12 years old. The licensee understands that each room approved for use has a maximum number of children allowed at any one time, but the overall capacity in the center cannot exceed 150 children.

The center offers childcare, preschool, and before/after school programming both full And part-time year-round for children ages birth to 12 years old. The center provides breakfast, lunch, and snacks for the children that is prepared in a centralized kitchen operated by the center. Transportation is provided by the parents and Madison School District. 3

During my onsite inspection on 7/26/22, I observed the children during mealtime, outdoor play, and nap/rest time. All of the rooms were equipped with an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment conducive to a preschool and childcare setting. The center provides the children with various daily learning activities to include circle time, name and letter recognition, school enrichment, calendar and counting activities, and arts and craft activities.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8143 Children's records.

(7) Physical evaluations must be updated as follows:


(b) Every 2 years for preschoolers.

Two children's files did not contain an updated physical evaluation signed by the physician or his or her designee that notes any restrictions relating to the child's health. The children's families have been notified and will provide the center with an updated physical evaluation to keep on file.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 07/26/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
