Approved Child Use Space:

Birth Toddlers & Beyond is located in a one-story freestanding building with a lower level located in Adrian, Michigan. The center utilizes five rooms as approved child use space: the main level infant room, toddler room, school-age room, and lower level 3-year-old preschool room, and preschool room.

The center offers both parttime and fulltime infant/toddler childcare, preschool, and before/after school programming Monday through Friday from 5:30 am until 5:30 pm, year-round. The parents provide lunch for the children. The center provides snacks for the children that consist of both fresh food and prepackaged food items that are prepared in accordance with the Children and Adult Care Food Program requirements. Transportation is provided by the parents and Adrian School District.

During my onsite inspection on 9/20/22, I observed the children during mealtime, small and large group activities, and outdoor play. All the rooms were equipped with an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment conducive to a infant/toddler childcare, preschool, and before/after care setting. The center provides the children with daily various activities that include circle time, name and letter recognition, counting activities, music and reading instruction, and various arts and craft activities. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing.

Approved Program Director: Ms. Trina Romanowski, Ms. Kimberly Purkey, and Ms. Te'a Romanowski are the approved program directors.

Approved Central Administrator: Ms. Trina Romanowski is the approved central administrator.
