I will assure the child care staff members provide the children with appropriate care and supervision at all times. On 7/18/23 Child A was not provided with appropriate care and supervision when Child A was able to walk into the roadway for approximately 10-15 seconds before being brought back to the group by a child care staff member. |  |  | <p>following day, 7/17/23, Child B was not provided with appropriate care and supervision when a child care staff member left him alone in the bathroom 5-8 minutes while the staff member returned back outside with the group of children. Since the incident, I have spoken with all of the staff members to remind them of the importance of assuring the children are provided with appropriate care and supervision at all times. We have discussed the importance of conducting random head counts at all times of the day to include during busy transition times. In addition, we also discussed the importance of positioning staff at the front and rear of the walking lines when transporting children. We reminded staff of the importance to assure they know what activities children are always engaged in, to include in outdoor play and positioning themselves where they are able to observe optimum view of the children at all times. In addition, the staff members know keep the Child A within close proximity of the staff during transition times. This violation has been corrected and will be maintained at all times.</p> |  |
