Approved Child Use Space:

The Adrian Head Start at Drager is located inside a two-story free-standing building operated by Adrian Public Schools. This building is not considered an active school as there are no children receiving educational instruction from grades kindergarten through 12th grade. The center utilizes thirteen rooms as approved child use space: room 100, room 101, room 102, room 103, room, 104, room 106, room 200, room 201, room 202, room 203, room 206, and room 208. The approved capacity is 192 children at any one time in the facility ages birth to 12 years old.

The center offers both parttime and fulltime infant/toddler childcare, preschool, and summer pre-K school programming Monday through Friday from 7:45 am until 2:45 pm, year-round for the child care programming. The preschool programming operates Monday through Friday from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm, through the school year. During the summer months, the center also offers a pre-K summer camp for children ages 4-5 years old Monday through Friday from 8:00 am until 3:00 pm. Transportation services are provided by Adrian School District and the parents. The center provides breakfast, lunch, and snack for the children. The meals are prepared in a centralized kitchen operated by Adrian School District. The snacks and meals provided are prepared in accordance with the Children and Adult Care Food Program requirements. There are no swimming field trips offered by the center.

During my onsite inspection on 6/14/22, I observed the children during outdoor play, small and large group activities, and nap/rest time. All the rooms were equipped with an

adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment conducive to a infant/toddler childcare, preschool, and before/after care setting. The center provides the children with daily various activities that include circle time, name and letter recognition, counting activities, music and reading instruction, and various arts and craft activities. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing.

Approved Program Director: Ms. Holly Johnson is the approved program director.

Approved Central Administrator: None

Approved Variances: On 9/18/2019, a variance was granted to licesning rule R400.8173(10) regarding equipment. The center is accommodating children with Individualized Education Plans. Some of the plans state as a part of their goals is to meet the children's needs for gross motor development opportunities. These goals are written by professional staff such as occupational therapists within the school district and have included the need for specific equipment to be used, such as a trampoline, to meet the children's individual needs for daily movement. The trampolines used would consist of the smaller type with support hand railings that would be used by one child at a time. The center will store and use the trampoline in a dedicated therapy space only. The trampoline will only be used by children whose Individualized Education Plan indicates this particular motor activity. The children will be closely supervised by caregiving staff while they use the small trampoline.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.
