Ms. Nichole Dodson, licensee designee will assure that all staff members provide appropriate care and supervision of the children at all times. Regarding the incident with Child A, Ms. Dodson has spoken with Ms. Samyera Qaimari regarding this incident. Although Ms. Qaimari had a close relationship with Child A outside of the center and did this incident in a "joking manner", I reminded Ms. Qaimari that Child A is a child enrolled in her care while she is working at	1/11/2021

		the center and needs to be treated the same as all child care children are treated. The center does not condone any use of physical punishment and will not tolerate any use of physical punishment even if it is done in a joking manner. I discussed with Ms. Qaimarai more appropriate ways she could have got Child A's attention to focus on his schoolwork by merely talking with him or sitting with him in lieu of "lightly tapping" him on his arm.
