Approved Child Use Space:

Montessori Children’s House of Lenawee is located inside a one-story free-standing building located in a strip mall in the city of Adrian, MI. The building is not an active school building. The center utilizes five rooms as approved child use space: toddler room, toddler transition room, preschool room 1, preschool room 2, and the school-age room.

The center offers both parttime and fulltime Montessori childcare for toddler aged children, Montessori preschool, and before and after school programming for school aged children. During the summer months, the center will also have a summer camp for school-aged children to attend from June through August. The center operates Monday through Friday from 7:00 am until 6:00 pm, year-round. The parents provide breakfast, lunch and snacks for the children. The snacks provided consist of fresh food and prepackaged food items that are ready to eat meals that only require reheating and are prepared food items in accordance with the Children and Adult Care Food Program requirements. Transportation is provided by the parents and Adrian School District.

During my onsite inspection on 6/12/23, I observed the children during outdoor play, and small and large group activities. All the rooms were equipped with an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment conducive to a Montessori childcare, Montessori preschool, and before/after care setting. The center provides the children with daily various activities that include circle time, name and letter recognition,

counting activities, music and reading instruction, and various arts and craft activities. Childcare staff member interactions with children was positive and nurturing.

Approved Program Director: Ms. Michelle Rion is the approved program director.

Approved Central Administrator: Ms. Karah Roesler is the approved central administrator.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes.
