Approved Child Use Space:

Lenawee Intergenerational Learning Academy Too is located inside the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) building. The USDA building is a one-story freestanding building located in Adrian, Michigan. The center utilizes four rooms as approved child use space: Infant room 1, Infant Room 2, Preschool/School-age Room, and School-age room.

The center offers both parttime and fulltime infant/toddler care, preschool, and before/after school-age childcare programming seven days a week from 4:30 am until 11:59 pm, year round. The center provides breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks for the children that are prepared in a centralized kitchen located in the center. The snacks and meals consist of fresh food and prepackaged food items that are prepared in accordance with the Children and Adult Care Food Program requirements. Transportation is provided by the parents and Adrian School District.

During my onsite inspection on 1/18/22, I observed the children during mealtime, small and large group activities, and nap/rest time. All of the rooms were equipped with an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment conducive to a preschool setting. The center provides the children with daily various learning activities that include circle time, name and letter recognition, counting activities, music and reading instruction, and various arts and craft activities. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing.

Approved Program Director: Ms. Marisa Cappelletty is the approved program director under licesning rule R400.8113(7)(f) and (12) since 01/18/2022.

Approved Central Administrator: Ms. Nichole Dodson is the approved central administrator.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8110                      Applicant; licensee; licensee designee; requirements.**

**(10) Written approval from the department must be obtained before making any changes in the terms of the license, including but not limited to, adding use space, changing age groups served, changing program components, changing the capacity of the center, or making changes to a room or well-defined space that will result in a change in capacity of the room or well-defined space.**

Ms. Nichole Dodson, licensee changed the school-age room to a toddler transition room without first receiving prior department approval. While onsite on 1/18/22, Ms. Dodson completed a modification request form and made the necessary changes to complete the room change.

**R 400.8143                      Children's records.**

**(7) Physical evaluations must be updated as follows:**  
**(a) Yearly for infants and toddlers.**  
**(b) Every 2 years for preschoolers.**

Two toddler-aged children's records did not contain an updated physical evaluation annually. Ms. Dodson has informed the parents and is awaiting copies of the children's annual physical evaluation conducted by a licensed physician or his or her designee.

**R 400.8143**

**Children's records.**

(8) Upon enrollment and annually thereafter, a center shall obtain and keep on file at the center a signed statement from a school-age child's parent confirming all of the following:

(a) The child is in good health with activity restrictions noted.

(b) The child's immunizations are up-to-date.

(c) The immunization record or appropriate waiver is on file with the child's school.

Two school-aged children's records did not contain an annual signed statement from a school-age child's parent confirming that the child is in good health, the child's immunizations are up-to-date, and the child's immunization record or appropriate waiver is on file with the child's school. Ms. Dodson has informed the parents and is awaiting new annual statements indicating the above.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 01/18/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
