Food/Snacks have been removed from the classroom cupboards. All open packages are labeled and in clean, covered containers. Ms. Church will monitor and maintain compliance.	08/05/2022
R 400.8320(1) Food preparation.	According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that there were multiple packages of expired food in the refrigerator.	The two items located in the child care staff members' refrigerator that were expired have been removed. Ms. Rutka will monitor and maintain compliance.	08/03/2022

R 400.8325(1) Sanitization.	According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that there were used wash cloths located at multiple sinks, air drying. Wash cloths used for cleaning should be immediately placed in laundry after use or stored in a sanitizing solution when not in use.	Used cleaning rags will be immediately placed in a bleach solution bath when not in use. Ms. Church and Ms. Rutka will both monitor and maintain compliance.	08/10/2022
R 400.8345(4) Water supply; plumbing.	According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector observed a bucket located under the kitchen sink holding water. It appears plumbing from sink may have a small leak.	The leak under the kitchen sink is scheduled to be fixed. Ms. Church will monitor and maintain compliance.	08/19/2022
R 400.8380(5) Maintenance of premises.	According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector observed paint peeling or chipped on walls.	Peeling and/or chipped paint will be repaired/touched up throughout the building. Ms. Church will monitor and maintain compliance.	09/10/2022
R 400.8380(3) Maintenance of premises.	According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector observed ripped screens located in the back room.	Ripped screens will be removed from the windows that are not used or repaired in windows that are used for ventilation. Ms. Rutka will monitor and maintain compliance.	08/19/2022
R 400.8380(1) Maintenance of premises.	According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that the child care center needed overall cleaning.	The center has been following a new cleaning checklist designating and alternating staff daily to keep the center clean.	08/05/2022

R 400.8385 Poisonous or toxic materials.	According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that there were multiple bottles of liquid not properly labeled.	The three-step cleaning (spray) bottles will be clearly labeled with contents and stored appropriately. Ms. Rutka will monitor and maintain compliance.	08/19/2022
