Dear Ms. Church:

This letter is a follow-up to the Environmental Health Inspection completed at the child care center on August 3, 2022. The child care center received a "B" rating.

The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8315(3) Food and equipment storage.

(3) Unpackaged bulk foods must be stored in clean covered containers, dated, and labeled as to the contents.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector observed multiple locations where food were not stored properly.

R 400.8320(1) Food preparation.

(1) Food must be in sound condition, free from spoilage, filth, or other contamination and be safe for human consumption.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that there were multiple packages of expired food in the refrigerator.

R 400.8325(1) Sanitization.

(1) All tableware, utensils, food contact surfaces, and food service equipment must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each use. Multi-purpose tables must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized before and after they are used for meals or snacks.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that there were used wash cloths located at multiple sinks, air drying.

Wash cloths used for cleaning should be immediately placed in laundry after use or stored in a sanitizing solution when not in use.

R 400.8345(4) Water supply; plumbing.

(4) All plumbing fixtures and water and waste pipes must be properly installed and maintained in good working condition.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector observed a bucket located under the kitchen sink holding water. It appears plumbing from sink may have a small leak.

R 400.8380(5) Maintenance of premises.

(5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector observed paint peeling or chipped on walls.

R 400.8380(3) Maintenance of premises.

(3) Roofs, exterior walls, doors, skylights, and windows must be weathertight and watertight and kept in sound condition and good repair.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector observed ripped screens located in the back room.

R 400.8380(1) Maintenance of premises.

(1) The premises must be maintained in a clean and safe condition and must not pose a threat to health or safety.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that the child care center needed overall cleaning.

R400.R 400.8385 Poisonous or toxic materials.

Containers of poisonous or toxic materials must be clearly labeled for easy identification of contents and stored out of reach of children.

According to the environmental inspection report, the Health Inspector indicated that there were multiple bottles of liquid not properly labeled.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by August 24, 2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
