III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided for the following:

R 400.8170 Outdoor play area. Please obtain an updated playground inspection report. The composite play structure is not approved for child care use per playground report dated 01/06/2012.

R 400.8315 Food and equipment storage. Please replace the lightbulb in the refrigerator in the kitchen.

R 400.8122 Lead Caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities. Lead caregivers for infants and toddlers shall have 3 semester hours, or 4.5 CEUs, or 45 hours of MiRegistry approved infant and toddler development and care practices within 6 months of hire. These semester hours or CEUs may satisfy a portion of the requirements of subrule (6) of this rule. (W.M.)

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
