There were three chemical bottles (Virex- a disinfectant, Glance – glass and multi-surface cleaner, and Crew Super Blue – mild acid bowl cleaner) stored on the cart where it is accessible to the children in care.	Program director emailed the principal and custodial manager to ensure that the custodial cart will not be kept in the Kids Kare space/Cafeteria. Principal and custodial manager agreed not to keep the custodial cart of cleaning products in the Cafeteria.	10/20/2022
