R400.8173(11) Equipment.	Trampolines and bounce houses must not be used by children in care at the child care center.
R400.8122(9) Lead Caregiver; Qualifications; Responsibilities.	Verification of the education, credentials, and experience of each lead caregiver shall be kept on file at the center or at MiRegistry, www.miregistry.org .
R400.8125 (5)(a)(b)(c) Staff;	A written statement must be signed and dated by staff and volunteers at the time of hiring or before volunteering indicating all of the following information: a) The individual is aware that abuse


volunteer; requirements	and neglect of children is against the law. b) The individual has been informed of the center's policies on child abuse and neglect. c) The individual knows that all staff and volunteers are required by law to immediately report suspected abuse and neglect to children's protective services.
R400.8112 (2)(b) Comprehensive Background Check; Fingerprinting.	Maintain a copy of the completed and signed form or forms for each individual entered into the child care background check system under the license.
R400.8128 Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.	A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.
R 400.8131(11) Professional development requirements.	Verification of all professional development required by this rule must be kept on file at the center or online at MiRegistry, www.miregistry.org . Verification must be issued from the training organization or trainer and include the date of the course, the name of the training organization or trainer, the topic covered, and the number of clock hours. Training hours from MiRegistry also meet this rule.
R400.8137(2)	Children 1 year of age and older may be changed in a bathroom standing up or on a nonabsorbent, easily sanitized surface, with a changing pad between the child and the surface.

R 400.8530(9)	The center shall not store flammable materials, including fuels, pressurized cans, cleaning fluids and supplies, polishes, and matches, in heat plant enclosures. These items may be stored outside of child use areas in metal cabinets or storage facilities accessible only to authorized personnel.
R 400.8170(16)	The depth of the loose-fill surface material must be restored to its required depth when it has moved or becomes otherwise compromised.
R 400.8125(3)	All supervised volunteers shall receive a public sex offender registry (PSOR) clearance before having any contact with a child in care. A copy of this clearance must be kept on file at the center.
