R400.8122(9) Lead Caregiver; Qualifications; Responsibilities. Verification of the education, credentials, and experience of each lead caregiver shall be kept on file at the center or at MiRegistry, [www.miregistry.org](http://www.miregistry.org).

R400.8125 (5)(a)(b)(c) Staff; volunteer; requirements. A written statement must be signed and dated by staff and volunteers at the time of hiring or before volunteering indicating all of the following information:  
 a) The individual is aware that abuse and neglect of children is against the law.  
 b) The individual has been informed of the center's policies on child abuse and neglect.  
 c) The individual knows that all staff and volunteers are required by law to immediately report suspected abuse and neglect to children's protective services.

R400.8112 (2)(b) Comprehensive Background Check; Fingerprinting. Maintain a copy of the completed and signed form or forms for each individual entered into the child care background check system under the license.

R400.8128 Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis. A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is

free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.

R 400.8131(11) Professional development requirements. Verification of all professional development required by this rule must be kept on file at the center or online at MiRegistry, [www.miregistry.org](http://www.miregistry.org). Verification must be issued from the training organization or trainer and include the date of the course, the name of the training organization or trainer, the topic covered, and the number of clock hours. Training hours from MiRegistry also meet this rule.

R400.8173(11) Equipment. Trampolines and bounce houses must not be used by children in care at the child care center.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I reviewed children's records and child care staff members files. I observed children initiated in large circle time which included literacy and singing activities. I observed small group activities, free choice and lunch time. The children participated in a fire drill and gym time. Child care staff members interactions with children were positive and nurturing.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
