Dear Mrs. Amy:

This letter is a follow-up to the incident that occurred at the child care center on 08/17/2022. The child care center rented an inflatable water slide for the end of the summer camp. The water slide had a splash pool at the bottom.

On August 18, 2022, I received a telephone call from Child A's Mother. Child A's Mother said Child A attends the preschool program located on 10300 Dexter-Pinckney in Pinckney. She didn't know that Child A went on a field trip until later that evening when they were home. Child A said she went on a field trip to the Summer Camp. Child A said there was a water slide at the Summer Camp.

On August 18, 2022, I called and spoke with Mrs. Amy regarding the water slide. Mrs. Amy said she rented an inflatable water slide from Priority One for the last day at Summer Camp.

Mrs. Amy texted a screen shot of the water slide, Emerald Rush Water Slide. According to the product description, the slide is 32 feet by 11 feet and is 18 feet high. The slide is approved for children ages three and older. The slide has a splash pool at the end of the slide.

On August 19, 2022, I completed a telephone exit conference with Mrs. Amy.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8840(6)	Swimming activity area.
	(5) All of the following safety equipment must be readily accessible: (6) The use of hot tubs and private wading pools is prohibited.
ANALYSIS:	On August 17, 2022, the Summer Camp program rented a water slide for the children. The water slide has a splash pool/wading pool at the bottom of the slide.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by September 13, 2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

17, 2022,

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.


