The Child Care Staff Member had limited sight lines of the child and the teenaged, supervised volunteer.	Violation Established
R 400.8167(3)	Indoor space. A center shall provide a floor plan of all child use areas to the department at initial licensure and before making structural changes or adding any child use space. Only space that has received prior approval for child use by the department may be used for child care.	During the inspection the children were led out into the unapproved hallway to continue programming. While in the hallway the bell rang for passing time for high school students. Those students walked through the group of child care children.	Violation Established
R 400.8340(3)	Food services and nutrition; provided by parents. Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply s must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.	During the inspection it was noted that 4 water containers and 6 lunch boxes were not marked with a child's name.	Repeat Violation Established Reference: : 3/14/2016 :Violation Established;
