There are eight individuals on the background check system that are no longer employed with the district, working at different locations or whose status is unknown. R 400.8119 (1) Site supervisor; qualifications; responsibilities.	For the school age program, child care staff members were not aware of who was the site supervisor.	Ms. Halpin will assign a site supervisor and inform the child care staff members who that is.	05/26/2022


R 400.8134 (3)(a) Hand washing.	Children arrived at the school age program and began eating their snack without washing their hands.	Child care staff members will ensure that children was their hands before snacks and meals.	05/26/2022
R 400.8161 (5) Emergency procedures.	A fire drill was not conducted during the winter quarter (Dec/Jan/Feb) for the preschool classroom. There was no documentation of fire drills conducted during the school age program for the past two years.	Ms. Halpin will ensure that fire drills are conducted quarterly.	05/26/2022
R 400.8161 (6) Emergency procedures.	There was no documentation of tornado drills conducted during the school age program for the past two years.	Ms. Halpin will ensure that tornado drills are conducted and logged.	05/26/2022
R 400.8325(1) Sanitization.	Tables were not washed, rinsed and sanitized after snack during the school age program.	Ms. Halpin will ensure that child care staff members are retrained on proper washing, rinsing and sanitizing before and after snacks and meals.	05/26/2022
R 400.8330 (10) Food services and nutrition generally.	A snack menu was not posted for snacks served during the after school program and children freely grabbed extra snacks without supervision.	Ms. Halpin will ensure that a snack menu is posted and that any substitutions/additions are posted on the snack menu.	06/15/2022
R 400.8330 (23) Food services and nutrition generally.	Children ate and drank while walking around the room and playing board and card games.	Ms. Halpin will ensure that child care staff members are retrained on food services and that children are not walking around or playing games while eating.	05/26/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
