III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

There was a ccsM that had not completed the required 2022 Health and Safety refresher training.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(4) Floors, interior walls, and ceilings must be kept in sound condition, good repair, and maintained in a clean condition.

The was chipped/cracked floor tiles in room #247 which could pose a tripping hazard.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/28/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

Note: Technical assistance was provided to Ms. Bruyneel regarding hanging dramatic play clothes to allow them airflow to aid in the prevention of transmitting communicable diseases.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this childcare center.
