- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

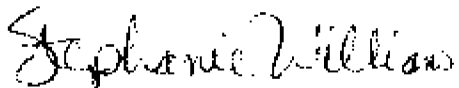
Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, a regular license will be issued. You will receive it in the mail.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.
During the onsite inspection and review of the records, I observed that child care staff member 1 did not have training in child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect prior to caring for children.	
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(4) Before unsupervised contact with children, all child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations.
During the onsite inspection and review of the records, I observed that child care staff member 1 did not have training in immunizations, prior to caring for children.	
R 400.8134	Hand washing.
	(2) All staff and volunteers shall wash their hands at all of the following times: (g) After handling bodily fluids.
I observed during the onsite inspection that child care staff member 2 did not wash their hands after wiping children's noses in the classroom.	
R 400.8134	Hand washing.
	(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times: (a) Before meals, snacks, or food preparation experiences.
I observed during the onsite inspection that child care staff member 3 and child care staff member 4 did not ensure children washed their hands prior to eating lunch.	
R 400.8152	Medication; administrative procedures.
	(4) Prescription medication must have the pharmacy label indicating the physician's name, child's first and last name,

	instructions, name and strength of the medication, and must be given according to those instructions.
I observed during the onsite inspection that Child L did not have a prescription label for prescribed medication (epi-pen).	
R 400.8173	Equipment.
	(4) Play equipment, materials, and furniture, must be all of the following: (b) Safe, clean, and in good repair.
I observed during the onsite inspection that the diaper pad and climbing mat material was worn and tearing in older infant room.	
R 400.8179	Program.
	(3) The program must be planned to provide a flexible balance of all of the following experiences: (a) Quiet and active. (b) Individual and group. (d) Child initiated, and staff initiated.
I observed during the onsite inspection in room #3 that child care staff members had difficulties in transitioning the children from circle time to diapering/restroom, to lunchtime. Children were observed during the following: climbing on top of book shelves, climbing under the table, knocking water cups/containers from the table, running throughout the room, etc. Child care staff members could not provide a flexible balance of the requirement above.	

I provided technical assistance for R400.8350(5) Toilets; hand washing sinks and R400.8380(3) Maintenance of premises.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
