R 400.8140	Child Care Staff members did not support each other and intervene when a child was being physically restrained to a cot during nap time.	Administration will review with staff appropriate means of punishment and a preschool setting childcare staff members will be trained to help support other childcare staff members who are in a challenging situation. The policy will be reviewed by the program director regularly.	3/31/23
R 400.8167	During the inspection staff members admitted to removing children from classrooms and taking them to nonapproved childcare spaces during child care hours.	All staff will make sure that children will be kept in approved child care spaces while in care.	3/31/23
