- R400.8345(4) Water supply; plumbing.**



III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.


During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:	
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.
I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records, that two child care staff members had not completed health and safety for calendar year 2020 and 2022.	
R 400.8170	Outdoor play area.
	(17) If children's wheeled vehicles and pull toys are used, then a suitable surface must be provided for their use.
I observed during the onsite inspection that the ground surfacing is uneven, cracked and with holes.	
REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED LSR DATED 05/24/2023. CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN DATED: 05/24/2021	
R 400.8173	Equipment.
	(4) Play equipment, materials, and furniture, must be all of the following: (b) Safe, clean, and in good repair.
I observed during the onsite inspection that the adult size chairs in two rooms were cracked and breaking.	
R 400.8345	Water supply; plumbing.
	(4) All plumbing fixtures and water and waste pipes must be properly installed and maintained in good working condition.

During the onsite inspection, I observed that in the boys restroom hot water faucet not working and loose faucet at the base in girl's restroom.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 05/23/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
