
<p>R 400.8325(4)(d) Sanitization. R 400.8325(5)(d) Sanitization.</p>	<p>During the onsite inspection, children's cups were washed and rinsed in the classroom sink. The classroom sink is a one compartment sink and the cups were not sanitized after being washed and rinsed.</p>	<p>Ms. Washington will ensure that all cups and food service equipment are washed, rinsed and sanitized in the 3-compartment sink in the kitchen.</p>	<p>05/09/2022</p>
<p>R 400.8380(1) Maintenance of premises.</p>	<p>During the onsite inspection, I observed the following: Peeling paint in the preschool classroom, toddler/transition classroom and preschool bathroom. Light bulbs burned out in the preschool and toddler/transition classrooms. A roof leak that spanned across the activity room and damaged several ceiling tiles. Large pot holes in the driveway where parents and children enter. A door handle of an egress door in the preschool room was missing.</p>	<p>Ms. Washington will patch the paint, replace the light bulbs, fix the door handle and speak with the landlord regarding the roof leak and pot holes.</p>	<p>05/23/2022</p>
<p>R 400.8545(3) Fire extinguishers.</p>	<p>Fire extinguishers throughout the building had not been serviced since 2020. The fire extinguishers were not inspected and maintained in accordance with NFPA-10.</p>	<p>Ms. Washington will call for the fire extinguisher to be serviced and have it serviced yearly.</p>	<p>05/23/2022</p>

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
