

One child care staff member did not complete training on prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations, before unsupervised contact with children. R 400.8131(5) Professional development requirements.	Two child care staff members did not complete all of the trainings listed in subsections (a) through (g) within 90 days of being hired.	Ms. Staff will ensure that all child care staff members complete health and safety modules 1 and 2 before working with children.	06/16/2023
