III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(5) A child care staff member shall keep all medication out of the reach of children and shall return it to the child's parent or destroy it when the parent determines it is no longer needed or it has expired.

An expired Epi Pen medication from November 2021 was found in room 123 that was not returned to the child's parent.

R 400.8350 Toilets; hand washing sinks.

(5) Hand washing sinks must have warm running water not to exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

The hot water hand washing sinks exceeded 120 degrees Fahrenheit in each of the classrooms. Room 121 running water read 145 degrees Fahrenheit; room 123 running water read 123 degrees Fahrenheit; and room 125 running water read 137 degrees Fahrenheit.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 04/12/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

An acceptable corrective action plan has been approved. I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
